# A GLIMPSE INTO THE WORLD OF KELLY MARBLE AAF AIFD TMF TEXAS TECH CENTENNIAL GALA

Kelly Marble and his Marble & Company team recently completed the amazing decor for the Texas Tech University Centennial Gala on April 29, 2023. Marble & Company is a high-end, full-service retail florist specializing in Special Events.

Texas Tech is celebrating their Centennial with a year-long celebration. The events began with a kickoff in December! "The Carol of Lights" events centered around the lighting of the campus with thousands of holiday lights around the main corridor.

Flower arrangements for this event featured all white Tulips to commemorate the tulips that bloom across campus each spring.





The Centennial Gala Celebration was held in the United Supermarkets Arena on the Texas Tech Campus. The entire arena was transformed into a virtual evening under the stars, with all decor in red and black, the colors of Texas Tech University. Guests were seated at all long tables, each covered with mirrored tops to reflect the dramatic lighting from the ceiling as well as thousands of candles.

All red flowers highlighted the evening event. Empress Protea, Anthurium, James Storeii Orchids, Rose varieties to include Freedom, Finally, Red Explorer, and Red Monster. Foliages best accented to include Aspidistra, Anthurium foliage, Monstera, and Lily Grass with red Hypericum. Marble and his team worked for over a year planning this event along with Blayne Beal, Director of Centennial Coordination, Office of the President Texas Tech University and Encore Live Events.

Marble is no stranger to Texas Tech. He was recognized as a Distinguished Alumni of Texas Tech University in 2019. Following graduation from Texas Tech University in 1984, with a degree in Horticulture from the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources, Marble rose to success early in his career and has excelled as an accomplished florist, event designer and business owner.

During his career, spanning more than three decades, he has become known as one of the most innovative and talented

designers, has been an industry consultant to international companies and was inducted into the American Academy of Floriculture (AAF) and the American Institute of Floral Designers (AIFD).

His unique design touch has transformed events as grand as the Academy Awards, events for heads of state and royal families, as well as numerous Texas Tech University and philanthropic events around Lubbock and the surrounding area.

Marble is a West Texas native, growing up in Floyd County, and has stayed true to his roots by choosing to operate Marble & Company in Lubbock.

Marble started at Texas Tech in the fall of 1980 to study his lifelong love of all things growing and natural. At the same time, he started working






