FIVE STEPS TO BECOMING A TEXAS MASTER FLORIST

- 1. Complete the Texas Master Florist Application available at tsfa.org or by contacting the TSFA office at 512.528.0806. Email the completed application to tsfaadmin@tsfa.org.
- 2. Upon approval of the application, you will be eligible to register online for seven of the ten courses in the Texas Master Florist Program. Proceed with the seven online courses, successfully completing the online exam for each class.
- 3. Register online for the three handson courses that are offered in person.
- 4. Once you have successfully completed all ten courses, you may register for the Texas Master Florist Program Final Exam.
- 5. Upon successful completion of the Texas Master Florist Program, you are eligible to test for Certified Floral Designer certification (CFD®) through the American Institute of Floral Designers (AIFD®). An additional preparatory course, to support the creative process, is offered through TSFA.

Become a Texas Master Florist The Study of an all Encompassing Curriculum

The Texas Master Florist Program provides a standard of professional excellence which has been recognized as one of the most complete educational curriculums in the floral industry. The series offers classes in Design Production and Floral Management with Texas Master Florist Certification. From the sales floor to the design room, from the delivery personnel to the office staff, from entry level employee to shop manager to owner, the content addresses the variety of skill sets required for a successful floral environment.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING CERTIFIED FLORAL DESIGNER CERTIFICATION (CFD®) THROUGH THE AMERICAN INSTITUTE OF FLORAL DESIGNERS (AIFD®).

- Texas State Florists' Association (TSFA) is an approved AIFD Education Provider and will submit your contact information to AIFD.
- At that time, if you are interested in pursuing this designation, you will complete the CFD® Application and submit the application with a \$174 certification fee to AIFD.
- Upon invitation from AIFD you will take the AIFD online test based on The AIFD Guide to Floral Design. This book is referenced throughout the Texas Master Florist Program curriculum and is a mandatory reference to achieve the Certified Floral Designer (CFD®) designation. The book is available through Schiffer Publishing at https://shorturl.at/dzJL5
- To receive CFD® certification, you must receive at least an 80% score within two (2) weeks of receiving access to the online test. There is a procedure in place to retest in the event your score does not meet the minimum requirement.

Texas Recertification is required every three years. There are numerous ways to achieve recertification.

1940 BEFORE THE STORE

Lee A. McShan, Jr. once said he "always knew he wanted to be a florist." He worked for 25¢ an hour during the depression for Otto Lang in Dallas and made corsages while at North Dallas High School for his classmates' parties and homecomings. After his service at Guadalcanal during WWII, he and Velma, who were married in 1940, were entrepreneurs eager to finally launch their careers.



1948

Velma and Lee A. McShan, Jr. purchase Roman Faltejsek Florist and Nursery. McShan Florist and Nursery opens on December 1st with two delivery vehicles, three employees and a dream to make \$35 a day. Twenty days later, Bruce Andrew is born. He and his big brother, Michael Lee, share a room in the tiny house next to the store.



1956 THE NIEMAN MARCUS ERA

In 1956, the McShan Florist embrace the start of a 20-year relationship with Neiman Marcus, which solidifies their business as Dallas' premier full-service florist.

1958

Lee A McShan. Jr. is elected President of TSFA.

1960

After giving the landscaping side of the business to his stepbrother in 1950, the entrepreneurs devote their efforts to becoming Dallas' most respected full-service florist. Mr. McShan felt commitments to both Dallas and the floral industry, serving as president of almost every organization of which he was a member. Velma proudly continues her work throughout the sixties with local civic, charitable and volunteer groups. She enjoys accompanying her husband on many of his activities, including extensive travel while he serves as an FTD Region 9 Director.

1966

One of Mr. McShan's most demanding roles was serving on the Dallas Independent School District Board of Directors from 1962-1968. In 1966, the DISD Board unanimously elects Lee A. McShan, Jr. President for a term that is marked by unprecedented growth.

1970

Mike receives his honorable discharge from the U.S. Navy. Bruce graduates Stephen F. Austin State University and both sons join the family business.

1979 NEXT GENERATION EXPANSION

By the late seventies, it was clear the store had outgrown its building. With steadfast commitments for future growth and development, the McShans decide to expand. The result is a 27,000 square foot state-of-the art facility like none other in the industry.



1982

At a time when their future held nothing but promise, the family suffers a tragic loss with the death of Mike at the age of 36. Mike is President of the Texas State Florists' Association at the time. TSFA honors Mike's memory and the family when they dedicate their new headquarters to him, placing this oil painting in its lobby.



1984

Welcome to the world, Elizabeth Jo McShan! Soon, Jodi is a regular fixture at the store, and everyone relishes time with her during frequent visits. By the age of three, she is happily filling water picks. Here she is with her Dad & DanDan.



1987

As FTD Convention Chairman, Bruce welcomes 1,500 FTD members to Dallas for FTD's 74th International Convention at the Anatole Hotel. He and his father are honored to host hundreds of guests wanting to tour the newly constructed McShan Florist building.

1990 A GENERATION LOST

The '90s will forever be remembered as the decade that McShan Florist Family sadly lost their founders. Mr. Mac, as he was affectionally known at the store, died following a heart attack on June 25, 1990. There are few men whose lives are remembered and even fewer who leave a mark on their community the way that he did. On March 10, 1996, Velma Cox McShan died suddenly at home while preparing to attend

church. Velma will forever be remembered for her kindness, elegance, compassion, and unwavering support of her husband and the dream they created in McShan Florist.



2004

Bruce was the honored guest speaker at the groundbreaking ceremonies for Lee A. McShan, Jr. Elementary School, held October 21, 2004, as well as the dedication ceremony at the school's opening in August of 2005 on Meadow Road. "My father lived the American Dream," Bruce assured students, families, and administrators at the dedication. "And he would want you to do the same. So, take your education seriously, work hard, be honest, trustworthy, set your goals high and reach for the stars," he encouraged.

Bruce says Jodi reminds him of his dad. "The more she's involved, the happier she is. I don't know how she does it all, but she thrives on the challenge and is incredibly organized." Floral industry offices, legal, community, volunteerism, fundraising, and social - if Jodi can make a positive impact, she's on board. The bottom line. "Actually, a legal background is a benefit

in any business, but everyone who knows me knows I am and always will be a true florist - it's in my blood."






