This year over 700 students tested at several sites including, College Station, Dallas, Canutillo, Pittsburg and San Antonio! You can see how much this program has grown! Another thing to pull out of the TFE bag is our annual Convention Fundraiser = \$1000. First prize = \$750 & 2nd prize = \$250. We also have the TFE Bookstore at Convention – the latest colorful volumes of floral design inspiration – all for sale at reasonable prices.

Herman Meinders AAF Continues to Support TFE Efforts Through Grant
